Mentor Expectations:

- 1) To be a role model for the boys and to live the expectations we have for them in dress and in manner.
- 2) To partner with another mentor and provide a small group mentoring experience for your mentees to include activities you do on your own, as well as, scheduled activities.
- 3) To establish a rapport with your mentees and the mentee’s parents. To Email or contact by phone your mentee once a week; and to make sure she complete and meets all deadlines.
- 4) To make sure my mentees abide by the Code of Conduct and to address their infractions within a timely manner (as soon as possible, but not to exceed 24 hours) with the mentee and if needed with her parent/guardian. To also inform Ms. J. Rushing of such violations and actions you take to correct the situation,
- 5) To schedule at least one activity in the fall and one in the spring that you will do with your mentees
- 6) To attend a minimum of 9 of the 13th Thursday meetings and to attend 2 of the Saturday
- 7) For one partner to attend the P2BK Saturday events and/or activities
- 8) One partner to attend the snow trip
- 9) For mentor partners to take the lead for one P2BKMonthly activity to include logistics, planning and implementation
- 10) For one partner to attend the six (6) Chicago Dance Lessons
- 11) Participation in the ORITA Ceremony
- 12) Participation in the Celebrating Success Banquet
